Biking through Caochangdi, looking for both food and art. Trying not to get lost – or maybe I was actually trying the opposite; getting lost. I coincidentally discovered Video Bureau. At the far end of the courtyard annex parking lot I saw a green metal door. The door just opened. Behind the door a hidden gem revealed itself in the form of an archive of contemporary Chinese video art. For those who aren't Beijing based, Caochangdi is a so-called urban village at the intersection of the fifth ring road and the airport expressway. Caochangdi, once a picturesque village, has now become known as an art district, swallowed by the ever expanding city

Video Bureau, established in 2012 is a non-profit organization that aims to provide a platform to exhibit, organize and archive video art. Next to the space in Caochangdi (Beijing) there is a second space in Guangzhou. Video Bureau aims to collect and organize artworks of video artists in order to build a video archive which is open to the public. Every two months Video Bureau adds the work of two new artists to the archive. Basically it works as follows: you consult the archive to check whether your favorite work is in the collection, or you saunter along the shelves and make a random pick. You can then watch the video on one the television sets. With the cold and long Beijing winter coming up, Video Bureau makes for a good spot to kill some time and spend an afternoon watching the work of e.g. Jiang Zhi, Hu Xiaoyuan or Yang Zhenzhong who might either prove to be your favorite video artists ever, or it could be your introduction to Chinese video art. Or if you can't make it to the screening of Cao Fei's *Haze and Fog* (2013) at Centre Pompidou in Paris on October 30<sup>th</sup>, get over to Video Bureau and watch it here. I guess it would be okay to bring your own popcorn. If you don't feel like getting lost and just want to go there straight away, here's the address:
